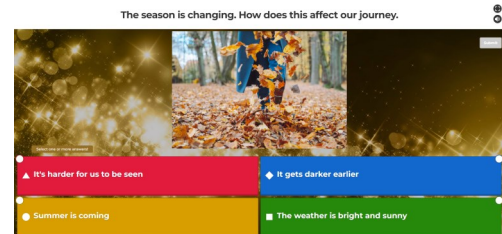
Hazel Class
